WILLAMETTE BACKCOUNTRY SKI PATROL**

This Volunteer Agreement is between the Willamette National Forest and Willamette Backcountry Ski Patrol.

Work will be prescheduled by the Forest Service who will provide technical as well as safety specifications, including Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) which will determine what personal protective equipment and safety practices will be followed. The JHA must be reviewed and signed by all participants prior to volunteering, or when changing type of worked performed.

Variable work party sizes to accomplish a variety of winter trail maintenance and patrol tasks including but not limited to: checking for hazards, administering first aid, contacting visitors, and providing information about winter recreation, regulations and future management goals. Some Sno-park and trail maintenance may involve labor such as lifting, bending, digging, and removing brush. Volunteers are expected to ski and snowshoe while performing duties that may be 2-10 miles from the sno-park.

The work occurs on rugged terrain in a variety of weather conditions. Volunteers will need to provide their own winter gear, food, as well as pack to carry personal and emergency gear.

A brief report needs to be submitted monthly. The report should include: list of participants and hours worked, areas traveled, work accomplished, trail conditions and additional work identified.

All work will be coordinated with the Recreation Planner- Mckenzie Jensen (541) 782-5338 Work party dates and locations will be coordinated prior to the start of work.

This agreement begins at the trailhead when you leave your vehicle.
